# PHOTOCOPYING AND PRINTING

At ground floor in the library there are 2 self service photocopiers: you can photocopy, scan and print personal and library materials for personal use and research, according to copyright laws.

There are 4 workstations to access the university electronic resources and internet and you can sign in with the University email address @unipd.it or @studenti.unipd.it.

# THE LIBRARY

The History Library of the University of Padua has one of the most comprehensive collections in Italy, which is constantly growing and being updated.

The physical holdings include approximately 95,000 volumes, 120 current and 500 discontinued periodicals, DVDs and CD-ROMs, and ancient printed material.

# The main areas of interest are:

- Medieval, modern and contemporary history;
- Venetian History;
- History of Christianity and Ancient Christian Literature;
- Palaeography, Archival Studies and Library Science.

The library buys all the handbooks and texts recommended for all history courses

Books and journals are for the most part freely accessible on the open shelf.

Some of the books and some discontinued journals are located in external storage facilities (Nuovo Archivio di Legnaro and Deposito di Palazzo Beldomandi): these materials can be booked through Galileodiscovery or requested at the front office and arrive at the library after a few days.

The library is open to everybody.

There are **104 seats in 6 reading rooms**; Room Lanaro is reserved to University of Padua scholars and professors.

**GalileoDiscovery** is a discovery service for searching books, articles, journals, and other resources.

By logging in, it is possible to access many customised services, such as booking a borrowed book, renewing loans, saving searches, and customising search results.

For institutional users who are part of the University of Padua (students, lecturers, researchers, staff, etc.), access is via their Single Sign-On (SSO) credentials.

Other users can authenticate via Social Login, using their Google, Facebook or X (Twitter) credentials.

#### **BORROWING BOOKS**

The service can be used by all university users and guest users possessing a library system Card (cost 1 Euro).

The University Library lends different numbers of books to different categories of readers.

- Professor, Scholars, Post Lauream, staff: 20 books/60days
- University of Padova students: 15books/30 days
- Guest user: 5 books/30days

Institutional users can ask for up to **5 renewals**, guest users up to **2 renewals** (if the items are not booked by other users)

# INTRA-UNIVERSITY LENDING

The intra-university lending service allows authorized users (professors, scholars, post lauream and students with disabilities) to obtain through their reference library books held in other libraries of the University of Padua Library System.

#### **INTERLIBRARY LOAN**

Through the Interlibrary Loan Service, you can ask for books that are not in Padua libraries by filling out the online request form.

# **DOCUMENT DELIVERY**

Through the Document Delivery Service, the University of Padua libraries supply users with copies of documents, such as journal articles, book chapters, etc, not available in any of their collections. All you have to do is to contact your library.
